**Syllabus Outline for the Admission Test:**

Admission test will be 1 hour; Total marks of the test will be 100 (40 marks on English, 40 on Mathematics, and 20 on General Knowledge on Business and Economics). Students willing to switch to BBA from other two disciplines will need to sit for an additional test (duration 40 minutes) designed for BBA.

## **General instructions for the applicants of BBA, English, and Law & Human Rights**

1. There will be one admission test for the BBA, English, and Law & Human Rights. The duration of the test will be one hour. Total marks of the test will be 100 (40 marks on common English and 60 marks for the evaluation of each department criteria).
2. The admission test will have four segments. Segment 1 will be an English test common for all candidates. The other 3 segments will be separate tests for BBA, English, and Law & Human Rights.
3. Students can interchange between English and Law & Human Rights. In other words, if a student is allowed in any of the discipline, s/he can make a choice.
4. Students willing to switch to BBA from other two disciplines will need to sit for an additional test (duration 40 minutes) designed for BBA. If any student is qualified for BBA, s/he will be eligible for the other two disciplines(i.e. English & Law & Human rights).
